With a few small changes you can entice local wildlife in your area to pay you a visit. Bird tables, nesting boxes and bird baths are simple ways to make birds feel at home in your garden.

Nesting box in spring - food table in winter

In spring, birds look for a place to lay their eggs and rear their offspring. The male claims his territory with repeated song as well as singing for his brooding female.

Later in the season, activity is focused on the feeding of the young in the nesting box.

During the autumn and winter months, a bird table offers the opportunity to become familiar with new bird species that arrive in their continual search for food.

Multiholk

Multiholk is a combined nesting box and bird table, built as a series of miniature houses that range in style from a traditional cottage to a modern functional house.

Designed with the aid of ornithological experts the result is a handcrafted product constructed in solid wood from well-managed forests and painted with environmentally friendly paints.

The houses are mounted onto a base plate that can be thoroughly cleaned. The bird feed is stored in a large 2 litre capacity container and fed into the feed chutes, where it is kept dry, sheltered from the wind and protected from bird droppings.

Multiholk is delivered complete with screws. All that is required for assembly is a cross-head screwdriver and a pole.

Multiholk is patent pending and design protected.

The modern house

The modern house (WG212) is a newly-developed Multiholk that is designed to be wall-mounted. The box is simply attached to a house wall or a tree using the screws that are included. There are two feeding holes in the bottom of the house, where small birds can easily find food that is well-protected from rain and snow. It is designed so that larger birds cannot get to the food, nor can it be contaminated by droppings. In the spring, the house becomes a nesting box in the same way as the other Multiholks.

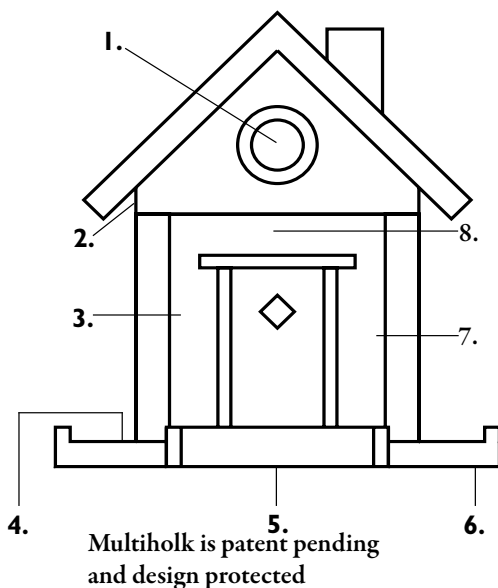

Construction



1. Entrance hole

Window that can be closed when Multiholk is used as a bird table. Window aperture is surrounded by extra hard wood to keep out woodpeckers. Suitable for most birds smaller than a house sparrow.

2. Ventilation holes

For ventilating the nesting box on warm summer days.

3. Feed container

Large containers with 2-litre capacity.

4. Feed Chutes

These prevent droppings from landing in food and reduce the risk of spreading infection. Bird feed is shielded so that it cannot blow away or be flicked onto the ground. Four long feed chutes provide ample capacity to feed many visitors simultaneously.

5. Socket for mounting on post

Mount it on a post at the chosen height with the accompanying screw. All you need is a cross-head screwdriver and a post with a size of 45 x 45 mm. When Multiholk is used as a nesting box it should be positioned at least 1.5 meters above the ground.

6. Base plate

Gives small birds an undisturbed refuge because it is too narrow for larger birds to settle on. Water drains away to prevent feed from getting wet. Seeds are fed from the container into the feed chutes through a cross bar.

7. Nesting box/ bird table

The plate in the feed container serves as a floor for the nesting box and is removed when Multiholk is used as a feeder.

8. Climbing notches

These make it easier for young birds to climb up the entrance hole when the time comes.

Abundance of breeds

With a spacious Multifeeder Barn, you can attract many different breeds of bird to your garden.

Here, there is the possibility of supplying four different types of food, everything from suet balls to peanuts, sunflower seeds and insect cakes. The greater the variety of the feed, the more breeds of bird will visit your feeder station. One breed also attracts another, which means that the Multifeeder Barn becomes a real "bird magnet" and creates life and movement in your garden.

The seed chutes are well protected

from rain and snow which, apart from meaning that the small birds can perch "with dry feet" and enjoy their meal, it also has the secondary benefit that larger birds such as jackdaws and magpies have difficulty landing to eat.

The Multifeeder Barn holds plenty of feed and therefore does not need to be constantly filled but when you do need to do this it requires no more than the simple manoeuvre of lifting the roof and refilling the barn with new food.

Cleaning it is also easy and the risk of various infections being transmitted between the birds has been minimised by

the fact that the birds' droppings fall onto the ground and not onto the table.

Assembly

Fix the barn onto a support out in the garden, or outside your window on our moveable swingarm (WG902) if you would prefer to avoid trudging through the winter snow to fill it up with new seeds.

Fixing bar and screws accompany the packaging, together with assembly instructions.

Townhouse - bird feeder

The Wildlife Garden's Townhouse bird feeder has been developed especially to suit a more urban environment. Designed in the same style as a town house, as well as being a meeting place for all sorts of small birds, they are also a pleasant addition to the general look of a town.

Bird feeder for small birds

The townhouse can be filled with bird seed but is also suitable for husk-free seed mixtures such as wildfowl muesli. Husk-free seeds are particularly suitable for feeding in a town environment as they do not cause litter, and they attract new,

exciting breeds of bird to the bird feeder.

The four feeding holes are designed so that small birds can easily find the food, and by using the perches, a bird can eat comfortably and hygienically without sitting in the food or contaminating it with its droppings.

The perches are too short for larger breeds of bird to land on, which means that the small birds can eat in peace. The seeds are well protected from rain, snow and wind and will not fall out if the house sways slightly in the wind.

The townhouse is a product that was developed in Sweden and handcrafted in

solid wood from well-managed forests.

It is easy to fill the spacious house with food (2.2 litres) by loosening the hinges, lifting up the roof and then pouring in seeds.

The bird feeder needs no fixing device, but is easy to hang up by using the accompanying hanging cord, in a tree or in a hook on the balcony. No other fixing is needed.

A series of hand-painted bird baths made of stoneware decorated with a common garden flower.

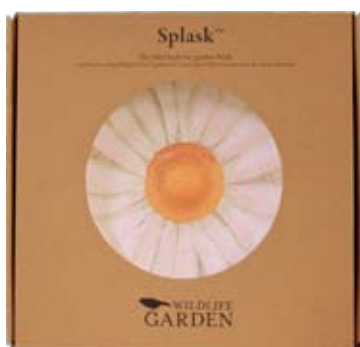
Splask from Wildlife Garden is a high quality bird bath developed to create a beautiful eye-catcher at the same time as it serves as a small birds' watering hole in the garden.

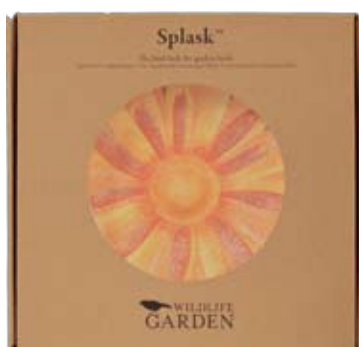
from stoneware to resist outdoor weather, all year round.

Did you know that you can attract twice as many birds to your garden if you provide them with water?

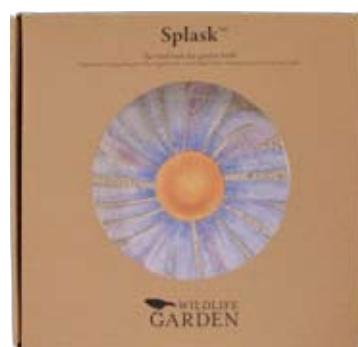

Bat Castle - nesting box for bats



Bats thrive in open country but like to be close to a building where there are plenty of insects. They also like water nearby.

Many European bats are now threatened species and putting up bat nesting boxes offers them an ideal home. A number of bat species live in holes in tree trunks, but as there is a lack of old hollow trees, boxes are a good alternative. It is good to put up several boxes in the same area, as bats like

to have other nests if they are threatened or disturbed. Another advantage of putting up boxes is that you avoid having bats in the house, because many bats like nesting in attics. They only need a small gap, just a centimetre, to find a way in. Bats are real mosquito hunters; a bat can eat up to 5000 mosquitoes in one night.

The box should be placed three to four metres above the ground and there should be free sight and access to and from the exit hole in the bottom of the box. This means that there cannot be any branches just outside. It is best if it is south-facing, but not in direct sunshine.

Butterfly hibernation boxes

Nectar rich bushes, wind protection and somewhere to hide during the nasty autumn weather. These are the things that attract butterflies to gardens.

The butterfly hibernation box like the Multiholk is constructed to resemble a miniature cottage.

As well as being decorative they provide hibernating butterflies, such as the small tortoiseshell,

peacock and brimstone with a refuge to creep into during the late autumn and winter. By filling the hibernation box with bark you create an environment which gives good protection against rain, wind and the cold.

The butterfly hibernation box is available in two colours: red and yellow.

The butterfly box has been designed with the aim of meeting the needs of butterflies during the winter, offering shelter and protection, as well as giving the garden a decorative feel throughout the year. By filling it with bark you create an environment where butterflies like to sleep. The butterfly box should be placed in a wind-free place in the garden where there are plants with plenty of nectar or bushes that attract butterflies.

The box has been developed in Sweden and has high standards of craftsmanship. It is built entirely in solid wood sourced from well-managed forests.

A symbol for change

With its life cycle from egg to larva and pupa to the butterfly, the butterfly has come to symbolise change.

What many people do not know is that butterflies, depending on the species, can hibernate at all different stages. The species that we can see early in the spring are those that have hibernated as fully-formed butterflies in a suitable place. Some of our most common butterflies had already hatched the previous autumn, and have thus been hibernating during the winter. When the sun in the early spring sun heats up the surroundings, they quickly come back to life again.

Most of the hibernating butterflies need food in the form of nectar, which they find in the early spring flowers. The most common hibernating butterflies are the tortoiseshell, the peacock, the brimstone and the Camberwell beauty.
