Bed and breakfast in the mountains

Wildlife Gardens latest in a series of prize winning Multiholks is a detailed timbered Mountain cottage. From a bird feeder in the wintertime to a nesting box for the garden's summer guests in no time, which is the Multiholk function. The mountain cottage is developed through ornithological expertise in order to suit small birds in a mountainous environment and winter climate.



In the winter time the Mountain cottage is used as a bird feeder for hungry small birds. The bird feeder can be simply transformed into a nesting box and a residence for the garden's summer guests. As a feeder the cottage holds 3 litres of seed, which are well-protected from wind, rain and snow and are therefore suited to a winter climate and mountainous environment.

The perches are a solution that allows the birds to avoid sitting in the feed, which prevents the feed from becoming a disease spreader. Thanks to the short perches larger birds find it difficult to sit down, thus providing the small birds with peace and quiet.

As a nesting box, the Mountain cottage is a residence that suits smaller birds such as sparrows and tits. On the interior there are notches under the entrance hole, this is an important detail so that the young birds can climb up and out to test their wings. The entrance hole is easily blocked with a barrier when the Mountain cottage is used as a bird feeder.

The Mountain cottage is easy to take down for cleaning or to fill with food, thanks to the mounting device that is fixed on a wall, tree or post where the Mountain cottage is hooked and unhooked. In order to avoid mould, we recommend cleaning the bird feeder several times per month.
