Attract new neighbours

The stained Tower nest box in natural colours is easily mounted in the garden and welcomes blue tit families and other small birds.

Our most common small birds will enjoy the Tower Nest Box, so count on tenants such as sparrows and different varieties of tits. The Tower Nest Box is manufactured out of solid wood and stained in three different natural colours, which means that it blends into the animal life's natural environment.

The blue tit is a bird with a large family that thrives in the Tower Nest Box. It is not unusual for a blue tit to lay up to 16 eggs in one brood. There are notches on the inside of the house, which allow the small family members to climb up and out to test their wings.

The Tower Nest Box is easily mounted on a wall, tree or post. Two screws are included, which affix the fixing device. The house can then simply be hooked on and this makes cleaning easier. When cleaning the house only use warm water to get rid of uninvited guests.
