Easier assembly on a wall means they move in faster

In just a few years, small birds have been given a far greater choice as regards diet and accommodation. Small, charming houses are transformed into a practical and well-visited dining area with just a few simple manoeuvres. The multi-nesting box that won the 2006 garden product of the year prize has now been joined by a newer version in the shape of the Modern House, especially produced for quick and easy assembly directly on to a wall or a tree trunk. Two screws and it's ready for moving into.

Even the output solution for the winter is somewhat different. Instead of a feed tray, the birds sit on pegs and eat from small, round holes in the bottom of the house. The food is protected from rain and foul weather and the pins ensure that droppings end up falling directly on the ground. The new output solution also makes it difficult for the larger birds such as crows and magpies to help themselves to the midday meal.

It's easy to remove the roof and bottom of the house for refilling and cleaning, and there are small notches in the walls on the inside to make it easier for the young birds to get out through the hole and test their wings.
